Requirements

International applicants must submit both Curriculum Vitae (max. 2 pages) and letter of motivation (max. 1,800 characters), which show personal interest and qualifications regarding the topic and proof of English language skills (level B2 is desirable). You can submit your documents within the application process on our website.

Scholarship and Accommodation

The RMS Summer School is supported by the DAAD with funds from the German Federal Foreign Office. Scholarships would be awarded for your travel expenses, accommodation, catering and insurance (if travelling is possible due to COVID-19). Your accommodation would be close to the campus Gelsenkirchen in a student hostel, where you will be accommodated in double rooms. Please observe both the travel warnings of the German Federal Foreign Office and the regulations on travelling in your own country.

The venue is the campus of the Westphalian University of Applied Sciences in Gelsenkirchen, North-Rhine Westphalia, Germany.
